

**RULES for The ECMTB 2018' Student Poster Award 11th European Conference on
Mathematical and Theoretical Biology (ECMTB2018) Lisbon, 23-27 of July 2018**

Article 1

To be eligible for the poster prize award, the poster must be prepared and presented by a student participating in the ECMTB 2018, as primary and corresponding author, although the scientific supervisor and other contributors can be co-authors. During the conference check in, participants must express their interest in becoming a candidate for the poster prize. The poster will be marked for the evaluation panel.

Article 2

Posters should be prepared according to the Poster Guidelines of the ECMTB 2018 (available in due time at the conference webpage www.ecmtb2018.org).

Article 3

A designated awarding committee will be responsible for the evaluation of the scientific quality and poster presentation.

According to the available sponsorships, the jury will distinguish 2 to 4 posters, each of which will receive a Diploma and a prize to be given to the first author. The Poster prize winners will be announced at the last day of the conference, during the prize ceremony. Should the first author not be available to receive the prize at the ceremony, a co-author or a representative may receive the prize on his/her behalf.

SPM will be responsible for all legal and financial matters SPM will be responsible for all legal and financial matters regarding each specific prize. The sponsor of each prize will be adequately acknowledged in the Diploma and also publicly during the Poster prizes ceremony.

Poster Prizes Sponsors will be announced on the conference's website: listing of logo, company name, and link of company website.

The evaluation panel's views will be final.

Poster presenters are requested to display the poster on his/her poster panel, that will be identified with a number (PXX) and name, in the morning of the session your poster is scheduled to take place. All posters must be removed immediately after the poster session is over, around 7:00pm of each day when poster sessions are taking place.

Poster maximum size: A0 Portrait orientation, or A1 Landscape orientation.
